Eco-Harvester Pledge Drive

In spring of 2018 it became clear to the Executive Committee of the Quiet Lakes Improvement Association that neither biological nor chemical methods would be effective in controlling Hybrid Eurasian Water Milfoil (HEWM) in Lost Land Lake.

After more than a year of thorough research into mechanical control methods, the QLIA ExCom has determined that our best option for long-term control of HEWM will be to buy and operate an Eco-Harvester weed puller.
